

## **PARTICIPATION RULES** **IN THE EVENTS OF THE 3 JOURS D'AIGLE 2020**

**The participation to the 3 jours d'Aigle is reserved for teams of:**

- 1 rider cat. U23 associate with 1 rider cat. Elite
- 2 rider's cat. U23

14 teams will be selected to participate in the 3 jours d'Aigle. If more than 12 teams register the selection will be made the 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2020:

- Registration limit is fixed on the 24 of August 2020
- A Maximum of 2 teams per foreign nation will be allowed to start
- The participation of Swiss teams will be limited to 6 teams
- The organizer will not accept registration of a team how not control enough the Madison technique.

The gear for Madison races is limited to 8,15m (50x14)

During registration, the riders must be included under "Palmarès" their best two results in Madison, in order to prove they master the technique of this discipline.

All the 24 selected riders have to order and to pay self the accommodation and meals, all selected riders will receive CHF 100.— per day (CHF 600.— per team for the 3 days).

The registration fees are € 25. -- / or CHF 30. —per rider. Only once. Even if the rider participates in several disciplines. The Organizer will take this amount from the price money.

It is possible to order meals ticket on the registration form. Lunch (restaurant CMC CHF 15.--)  
Dinner (Infield CHF 8. --)

## The participation to the Mini 3 jours d'Aigle is open to following teams:

- 2 riders of the cat. U19
- 2 riders of the cat. Elite Women
- 1 riders of the cat. Elite Women and 1 cat U19 men

Two U23 rider or one U23 rider and one U19 rider or one U23 rider associated with one Elite Women rider can be allowed to run the Mini 3 Days if her level is deemed insufficient to participate in 3 Days of Aigle.

12 teams will be selected to participate in the Mini 3 jours d'Aigle. The selection for the Swiss and French teams from the region, will be made during all Madison practices taking place Sunday 13 September 11h00 – 16h00 at the Tissot Velodrome at Grenchen, and at the World Cycling Centre at Aigle the Saturdays 12 and 26 September 11h00 – 16h00. Final selection will be made after the training on Saturday 26 September in Aigle.

The gear for Madison races is limited to 7,50m (49x15)

During registration, the riders must be included under “Palmarès” their best two results in Madison, in order to prove they master the technique of this discipline.

The 24 selected riders will be taken in charge, accommodation and meals, against a participation of CHF 70. - or € 65.-, including registration fees, from Thursday, October 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 (dinner) until Saturday October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2020 (dinner).

For riders who sleep at home or reserve their accommodation themselves, it will be asked a participation of CHF 30. - or € 25. – including 3 dinners.

If asked, we can organize accommodation and meals for a staff member by Mini's team. For this organization we will ask a participation of CHF 55. -- / € 50. —per day. If more than one staff member is coming to the 3 jours d'Aigle every additional staff member has to take care of their accommodation themselves.

**The participation to the Piccolo 3 jours d’Aigle is reserved for teams composed of:**

- 2 riders from cat. U17
- 2 riders from cat. Women FB and U19

A U19 rider associated with an U17 rider or 2 riders U19 or n U19 rider associated with a FB Woman may be allowed to run the Piccolo 3 Days of Aigle, if their level is deemed insufficient to participate in the Mini 3 Days.

12 teams will be selected to participate in the Mini 3 jours d’Aigle. The selection for the Swiss and French teams from the region, will be made during all Madison practices taking place Sunday 13 September 11h00 – 16h00 at the Tissot Velodrome at Grenchen, and at the World Cycling Centre at Aigle the Saturdays 12 and 26 September 11h00 – 16h00. The end of the registration will take place on August 24th and we will do the definitive selection on August 31st 2020.

Depends on the number of registrations, a maximum of 2, 3 or 4 riders per foreign nation will be authorized to compete, to ensure the biggest number of nations can take part.

Every participant who take part in an UCI race, unless they are riding the Mini or Piccolo 3 jours d'Aigle, will have to organize their accommodation and meals.

It is possible to order meals ticket on the registration form. Lunch (restaurant CMC CHF 15.--)  
Dinner (Infield CHF 8. --)

Registrations fee are CHF 30.-- / € 25.-- per rider. This amount has to be paid only once even if the rider is taking part in several UCI races during the three days.

If a delegation has staff member, he has to take care of his accommodation and meals by himself.

On demand, the 3 jours d'Aigle can take care of the organization of the accommodation for the national teams.
